

Prof. Thomas Potthast

Thomas Potthast is Full Professor for Ethics, Philosophy and History of the Life Sciences, and Co-Director of the International Centre for Ethics in the Sciences and Humanities (IZEW) at the University of Tübingen, Germany. He studied biology (Diploma 1993) and philosophy at Freiburg, Germany, followed by a PhD at Tübingen (1998) with a study on links between evolutionary biology, ecology and environmental ethics. He was PostDoc at the Max-Planck-Institute for the History of Science, Berlin (1998-2001) followed by a Fellowship of the Humboldt Foundation at the University of Madison-Wisconsin, Department History of Science and Centre for Environmental Studies. His research and teaching deals with ethical dimensions of science, also addressing conceptual and practical questions of interdisciplinary and transdisciplinary research at the science-society-interface, with a special focus on the life sciences and sustainable development.
